

Home to the endangered mountain gorillas, the park also features dramatic volcanic peaks, dense montane forests, and rare golden monkeys. Mountain Gorilla trekking permits are strictly limited to ensure conservation and an intimate experience. Advance booking is essential.



Spanning over 1,000 square kilometres, Nyungwe is home to rare primates, including chimpanzees and colobus monkeys, as well as over 300 known bird species and hundreds of plant varieties.

Discover endemic species like the Rwenzori Turaco and Great Blue Turaco. Nyungwe is one of the top birding destinations in Africa.



# Travel Tips & Planning

Our Personal Notes To Help You Travel With Ease

### Air Travel

**Kigali International Airport (KGL)** is the main entry point and is just 20 minutes from The Pinnacle Kigali.

### **Best Travel Season**

- June to September and December to February are the ideal months to visit Rwanda. These dry seasons offer the best conditions for mountain gorilla trekking and national park visits.
- If you're planning a wildlife safari or trekking expedition, these months provide easier hiking trails and more wildlife visibility.

### Visas

- Most visitors can apply for an e-Visa online via migration.gov.rw.
- An East African Tourist Visa is also available, allowing travel across Rwanda, Uganda, and Kenya with a single visa.

### National Park Permits

- Mountain gorilla trekking permits must be reserved months in advance due to high demand and limited availability.
- Permits for chimpanzee tracking, golden monkey tracking, and volcano hikes are also recommended to book early, especially during dry seasons.

# Health & Safety Guidelines

Yellow Fever vaccination is recommended and may be required depending on your origin of travel.

# Languages Spoken

- Rwanda has four official languages: Kinyarwanda, English, French, and Swahili.
- French and English are widely spoken in urban areas and hospitality settings, especially in Kigali.

### Currency

- Local currency: Rwandan Franc (RWF)
- Credit cards are accepted in most hotels and upscale restaurants, but cash is recommended for local markets and rural areas.
- ATMs are readily available throughout Kigali.

# Ground Transportation

- Chauffeured vehicles can be arranged via our trusted tour operator partners.
- Self-drive car rentals are available, but we recommend the comfort and local expertise of a private driver.

### Helicopter Transfers

For guests with limited time and an ample budget, helicopter transfers to Volcanoes or Akagera National Parks can be arranged on request.
